

## The Trifecta!

Here are three fun and handy gadgets to add to your goodie bag.

**Kingston MobileLite G2:** Kingston's MobileLiteG2 is a compact, portable, multifunctional card reader that lets you easily transfer digital data, photos, games, music, and more stored on memory expansion cards to all kinds of digital devices.

It's designed for use with different types of SD/SDHC and microSD/SDHC Flash memory cards. MobileLiteG2 lets you carry a single device to store, transfer, or read data on any USB host device while using a variety of flash cards for mobile phones, digital cameras, Netbooks, computers, MP3 players, and more. This is ideal for personal or professional use and will quickly become an essential part of your mobile gear. It's ultra-portable, plug and play, and requires no external power source.

It has retractable covers on each side to make it compact and protect the USB connector and the Flash memory cards from damage. It includes a dongle, a USB extension that allows you to plug the MobileLiteG2 into USB slots that are harder to reach. When in use, MobileLiteG2 appears as two drive letters and data transfer is as simple as drag and drop. So, now you can easily move photos to your PC from your digital camera without a cord; copy music from your PC to your MP3 player phone; or move photos, music, or videos to and from your child's DSi with ease!

And the price is certainly right. It starts at \$6.50 and goes up depending on what size SD card you want included.

**Otoma PK101 Pico Pocket Projector:** This microprojector is the smallest projector you have ever seen and weighs just 4 ounces. It easily share photos and videos from mobile devices and project images on any surface. The image size is up to 60 inches. Connect to your iPod, iPhone, and iTouch with the included bundled connection kit, or connect to Camcorders, DV-cams, DVD players, and other video players enabled with standard composite AV Out with the included composite cable. Note that this configuration does not connect to notebook computers, PCs, PDAs, cell phones, or other devices unless the device has composite output.

**Rotating Single Outlet Surge:** Easily convert any outlet into a surge-protected outlet with this Zoitek single-outlet protector. It also rotates 360 degrees, so you don't ever block the second plug, and it costs less than \$5. Or, if you need a bit more, try the Belkin three-outlet Travel Surge Protector, with three outlets and two USB charging ports. It has a 360-degree rotating plug with four locking positions, it includes a mini-USB cable to charge virtually any USB device including BlackBerry and Motorola RAZR phones, and it costs less than \$20.
